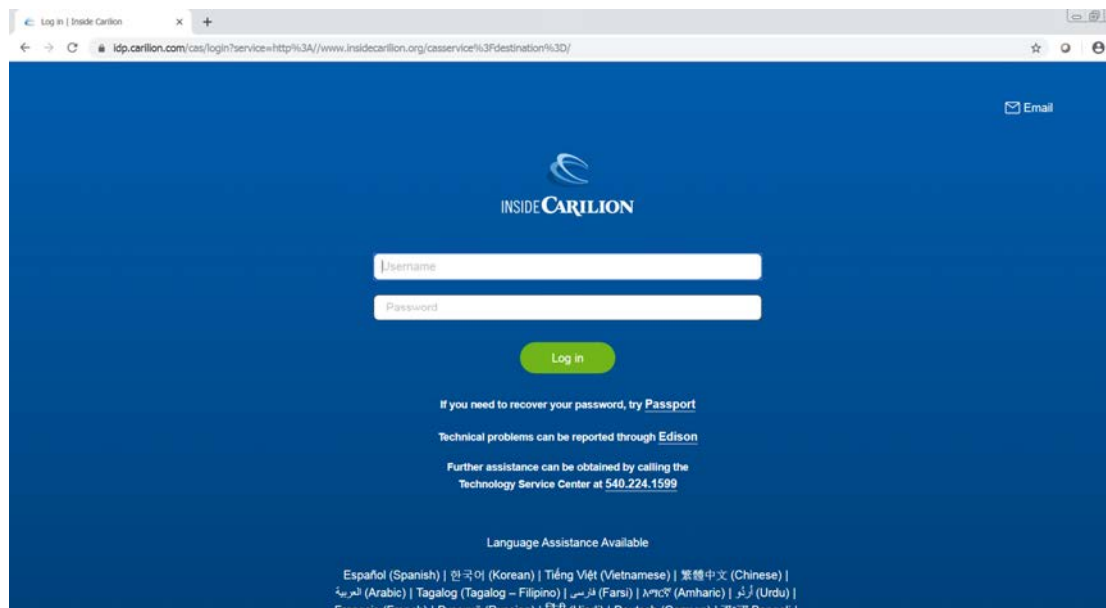
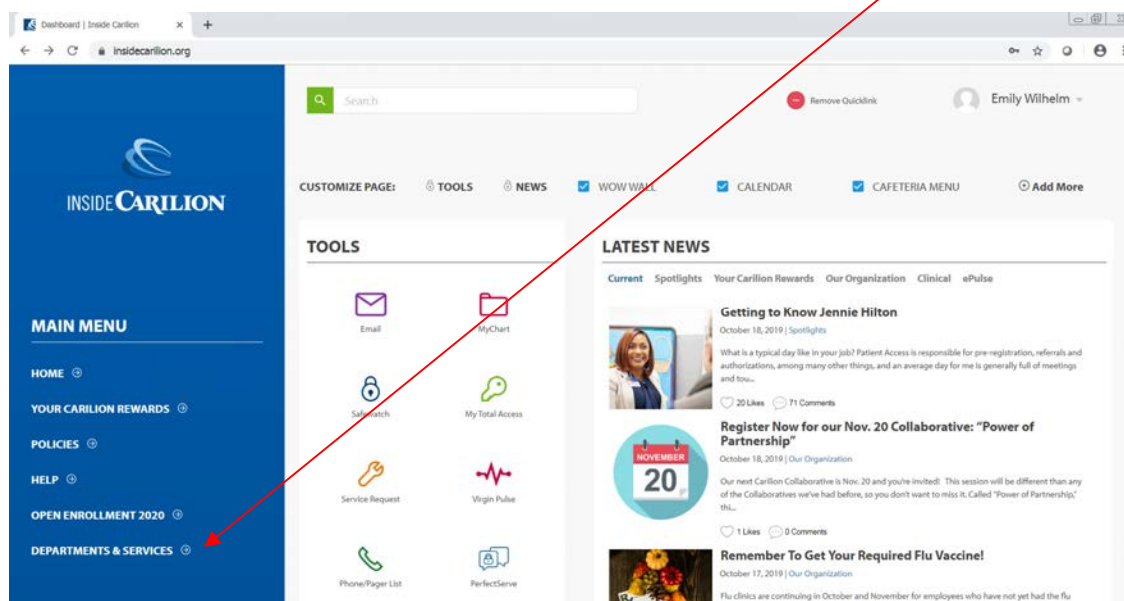

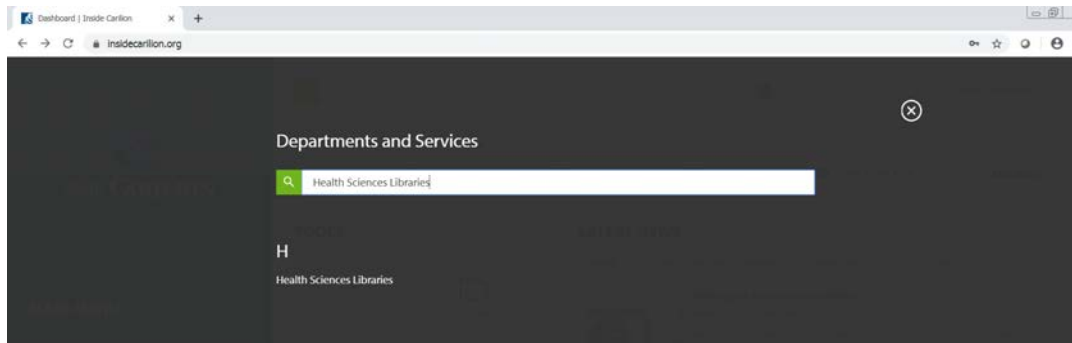
1. Open a web browser and navigate to the Carilion Clinic Intranet page at [insidecarilion.org](http://insidecarilion.org). Log in with your Active Directory Username and password.



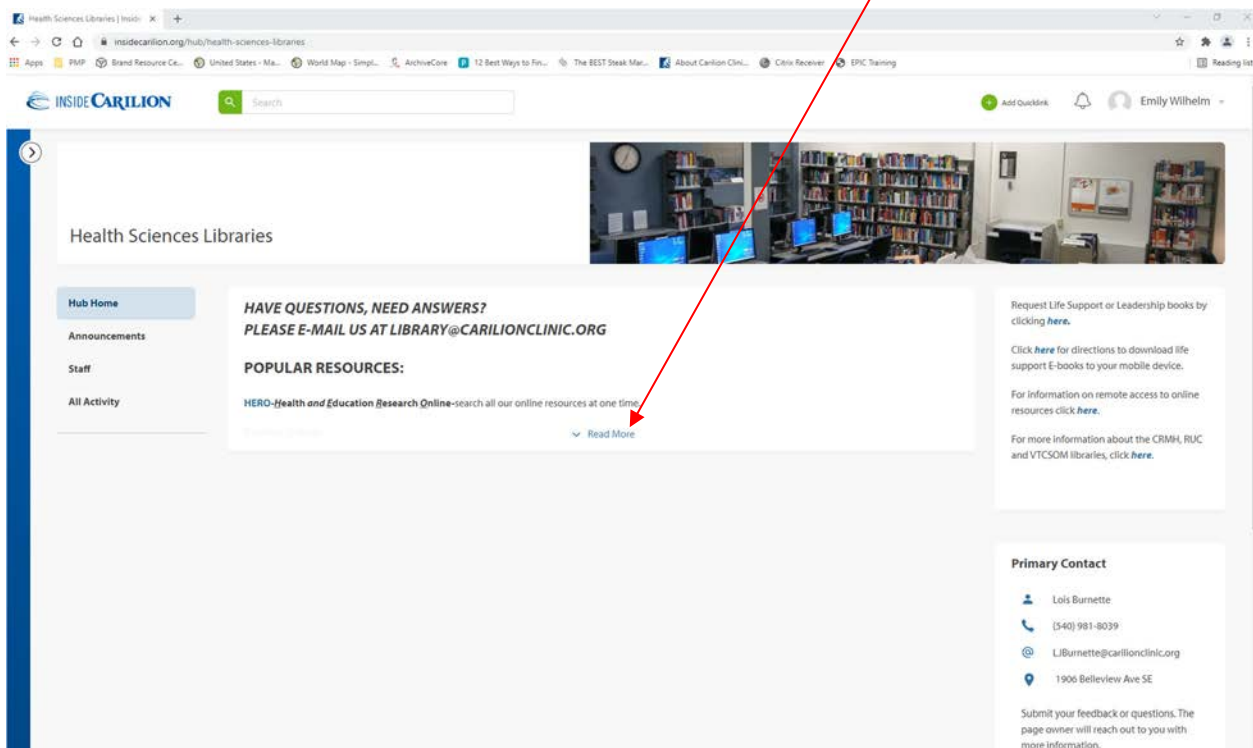
2. From the Home screen, click on Departments & Services.



3. Either type the words “Health Sciences Libraries” in the search bar or scroll down in the list and click on Health Sciences Libraries.



4. Once on the Health Sciences Libraries page, click Read More.



5. When you click Read More, the page expands to list the resources available from the Health Sciences Libraries. The links to PubMed Linkout and MyAthens are highlighted. If you do not have a MyAthens account, click the link in the word "HERE" for instructions to register for an account.

You can also get to journal content by using one of our many “aggregator” resources:

Google**Scholar** (not Google) <https://scholar.google.com/> for best results:

*Click on the triple bar in the the upper left corner*

*Click on “settings”, then “library links”*

*Start typing in “Carilion” and it should bring up the library name and choose it along with the “WorldCat” option.*

*Do a search and you will see entries on the right to access full text content if available.*
